
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Who are we?

Accomplishments

How can I help?

We are a labor union representing staff and faculty at UW-Eau Claire. We are affiliated with the American Federation of Teachers and the AFL-CIO. We work with unions across the UW System and in Eau Claire to advance the shared interests of students, staff, faculty, and the state. We aim to build a vibrant, strong, university that advances the common good.



We do not engage in collective bargaining, which was made illegal for UW faculty and academic staff in 2011.

We are an advocacy group, lobbying to pass pro-student and pro-worker policies through Shared Governance (e.g. University Senate), and putting pressure on administration to enact those policies, if necessary.

We support one another, help employees to learn their rights, build connections with co-workers across campus, and combine our voices and our energy for better pay and working conditions.

We have a history of success. Here are a few of our recent victories:

- Better Working Conditions for Academic Staff: In 2022-23, our campaign to combat exploitation of lecturers led to the elimination of the "No Intent to Renew" title and to new contracts with additional job security for dozens of lecturers.
- Pandemic Public Health: In 2020-2022, we won additional health and safety precautions for health workers on campus and led a campus-wide public health campaign.



- EDI and Academic Freedom: In 2024 and 2019, we passed resolutions through University Senate affirming our shared values of EDI and academic freedom.
- Defense of Shared Governance:
 In 2017, we passed a resolution through University Senate to affirm the value of shared governance and condemned academic policymaking by administrative fiat.
